

Experienced Practitioner Practicum 2010

The primary focus of this course, led by Richard Wallstein, will be on practical aspects of facilitating systemic constellations in groups. There will be separate modules on the Initial Interview, The Stance of the Facilitator When Facilitating and Putting the Parts Together, three two-day modules in total. Each module will comprise teaching, modelled session(s) and participant practice in pairs or groups.

The initial interview is a more complex and nuanced process than it can appear. Understanding the possibilities and pitfalls in this phase can provide the facilitator with a great deal of support for what follows. This module will provide an explanation of the sub-processes of which the interview is composed and provide the time to observe and practice them.

In the Stance of the Facilitator module, you will have the opportunity to learn more about diagnosis and the process of combining a phenomenological stance, related to presence, with the kinds of thinking that supports the work in progress. In this way, you will begin to develop your stance.

The third module will provide space and teaching/coaching for participants to conduct complete interview and constellation sessions.

The course will comprise three two-day modules and will be lead by Richard Wallstein. Space is strictly limited. Applicants should have experience of facilitating constellations and be expecting a supervision and not a personal work type of course orientation. In order to support the practice elements of the course, participants should also be prepared to share personal issues with exercise and practice-session partners.

Richard Wallstein, PhD, C.Psychol, UKCP Reg – is a senior teaching faculty member; he has a background in psychology and gestalt psychotherapy and began studying Hellinger's work in 1993, working with many practitioners. He has been leading workshops and trainings internationally for many years and has private psychotherapy and consulting/coaching practices in London. He was a founding board member of ISCA, the International Systemic Constellations Association.
